

Code Reviews

- Team members reading each other's code
- Often built-in to the team's development process
 - Can require that code be reviewed before it is merged

- What to look for

- Style

- Consistent with the project

- Organization

- Naming of variables, functions, etc.

- Correctness

- Efficiency

- Clarity

- Benefits

- Find errors
- Ensure readability
- Ensure maintainability
- Spread knowledge of the codebase
- Get new team members up to speed
- Expose team members to different approaches

- Some best practices

- Everyone does reviews

- If code reviews are only done by a few people

- They can burn out

- Fewer people see a lot of the code base

- Critiques are not personal

- Be respectful
