

File types

- In POSIX systems

- Regular files - contain data created by user processes
- Directories - files for maintaining filesystem structure
- Character special files - pseudofiles used for I/O
- Block special files - used to access disks

- Text files

- Encoded with ASCII, UTF-8, ISO-8859-1, etc.

- Binary files

- Not text files - executables, archives, non-text media, etc
- Executables must be in a system-specific format to be executed
