File types

- In Posix systems

- Regular files contain data created by user pousses
- Directories files for maintaining filesystem structure
- Character special files pseudofiles used for I/O
- Block special files used to access disks
- Text files
 - Eucodes with ASCII, UTF-8, ISO-8859-1, etc.
- Binary files
 - Not text files executables, archiver, non-text media, etz
 - Executables must be in a system specific format to be executed
